#### § 77-1. Adoption of standards.

A certain document, one copy of which is on file in the Borough Office of the Borough of Westfield, being marked and designated as the "BOCA National Fire Prevention Code," Tenth Edition, 1996, as published by the Building Officials and Code Administrators International, Inc., be and is hereby adopted as the Fire Prevention Code of the Borough of Westfield in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, for the control of buildings, structures and premises as herein provided, and each and all of the regulations, provisions, penalties, conditions and terms of said BOCA National Fire Prevention Code are hereby referred to, adopted and made a part hereof as if fully set out in this chapter, with the additions, insertions, deletions and changes, if any, prescribed in § 77-2 of this chapter.

#### § 77-2. Additions, insertions and changes.

The following sections are hereby revised as follows:

- A. Section F-101.1. Insert "Westfield Borough."
- B. Table F-107.2.3. Insert "no" on each line in the column headed "Permit required" and "\$0.00" on each line in the columns headed "Permit fee" and "Inspection fee," except for line F-2102.1. Insert "yes" on line F-2102.1 in the column headed "Permit required," "\$1,000" on the line in the column headed "Permit fee," and "\$0.00" on the line in the column headed "Inspection fee."
- C. The definition of "approved container," in regards to open burning, is added as follows: **[Added 8-13-2003 by Ord. No. 289]**

APPROVED CONTAINER — A container of steel or brick or other fireproof material totally enclosing all burning debris so that none of it can escape from the confines of the container.

#### § 77-3. Violations and penalties. **[Added 8-13-2003 by Ord. No. 289]**

Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of the BOCA National Fire Prevention Code, upon conviction before a District Justice, shall be subject to a fine of not

more than \$1,000 and costs of prosecution and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than 30 days.
