§ 105-1. Prohibited acts.

- A. No person shall cause or tend to cause any danger, discomfort or annoyance by any act, words or conduct to any of the inhabitants of the Borough or users of the streets, sidewalks, alleys or public ways of the Borough of Westfield.
- B. No person shall loaf, loiter or congregate upon any of the streets, sidewalks, alleys or public ways of the Borough of Westfield to the annoyance of peaceable residents nearby or traveling upon any street, sidewalk, alley or public way of the Borough of Westfield.
- C. No person shall consume, transport or possess on his or her person or in a motor vehicle any beer, wine or alcoholic beverage in an open container in or upon the streets, sidewalks alleys or public ways of the Borough of Westfield.
- D. No person shall consume or possess any beer, wine or alcoholic beverage in an open container in or upon the property of another unless that person is a guest, licensee or invitee of the owner or occupier of the property.

§ 105-2. Terms defined.

The terms "streets," "sidewalks," "alleys" or "public ways," as used in this chapter, shall be given the common definition thereof and shall include those parking areas of private shopping centers under the jurisdiction of the Borough Police of the Borough of Westfield, Tioga County, Pennsylvania.

§ 105-3. Violations and penalties. [Amended 8-13-2003 by Ord. No. 289]

Any person who violates any provision of this chapter shall, upon summary conviction, be fined not more than \$1,000 and costs of prosecution and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, be imprisoned for not more than 30 days.
